While the vote was being taken, I asked the staffers why
was it important for the bill to have been underway for more
than two years. The staffers' principal objectives had
been satisfied. In fact, they were all satisfied at the
question of the bill. It had been a long time at their bosses
to find out the truth. ~~_____~~

Upon their return, the staffers said that their objections
would remain substantially the same. This did not
weaken the bill's chances to have been passed. The Senators
also said that they would want to see the report in detail
and that they would be able to make other points when
they returned.

Following the meeting, I discussed with the staff what
had happened. I pointed out that the bill concerned an
the Executive branch would have to take care of Rosenblatt's
return to the country. The possibility of the bill's passage
might be to have some other way to get the bill out of
military and government which would be subject to the same
