SUBJ: CLEAN-UP COSTS

1. AS MATTERS NOW STAND THE FUNDING SUPPORT FOR CLEAN-UP COSTS CANNOT EXCEED \$520,000 FOR FISCAL YEAR 1969. THE BALANCE OF FUNDS WILL BE HELD AT THIS HEADQUARTERS FOR MAC AND MSTIS TRANSPORTATION, PORT HANDLING AND PER DIEM. I AM CONCERNED ABOUT THE CURRENT RATE OF EXPENDITURE AND COMMITMENT PARTICULARLY THE FOUR WEEK PERIOD ENDING 16 MARCH. I ASSUME THIS RATE REFLECTS PROCUREMENT OF INVENTORY WHICH WILL BE CONSUMED IN SUBSEQUENT WEEKS. I TRUST THE RATE OF EXPENDITURE AND COMMITMENT WILL REDUCE TO A POINT SHORTLY THAT WILL PERMIT WORK TO CONTINUE AND TO INSURE THAT CURRENT FUNDS ARE NOT EXCEEDED BY 30 JUNE.

2. I KNOW YOU SHARE WITH ME THE CONVICTION THAT THE JOB MUST CONTINUE AND FUNDS MUST NOT BE OVEREXPENDED. IF AT ANYTIME YOU FEEL EITHER TO BE IN JEOPARDY I WILL APPRECIATE YOUR EARLY ADVICE.
