This responds to your May 15, 1978, letter proposing an agenda for the next meeting of the Enewetak Advisory Group scheduled for the week of June 5, 1978, at Livermore. Included are the collected comments from Joe Deal, Tom McCraw, and myself.

We suggest the following priority assignments to subject categories listed below in order of decreasing priority:

- 1. Progress on items a through f in the April 28 report.
- 2. Reporting on Enswetak field operations, plans, and requirements.
 - a. Land use restrictions/quarantine.
 - b. Certification.
 - c. Bill Robison's report on recent activities.
 - d. IMP.
- 3. 13 Atoll survey plans.
- 4. Advisory group charter, organizational responsibilities, and identification of long-term issues.

We further suggest in response to your question, that items 1, 2, 4, and 7 be presented as follows:

Item 1 - 13 atol1 survey briefing.

Overview - J. Deal, OES DOD liaison - NV (possibly Roger Ray) Program plan - T. McCraw, OES Items 2 6 4 (combined) - Progress on "a" through "f" and IMP operations.

Progress on "a" through "d" - McCraw, Deal, OES

Progress on "e" and "f" - NV (possibly Roger Ray)

Item 7 - Long-term fissues (viewed to include all DOR activities in the Marshall Islands).

Long-term radiological followup - McCraw, OES

Research - BER

Regarding the orientation trip to Enewetak, we expect that one person from OES, yet to be named, will go. We are also investigating with BER the possibility that the once-a-year review of OES and BER supported Marshall Islands external assistance projects, be conducted just before the Enewetak trip such that it could be a part of that travel schedule. We can discuss this further next week.
