SUGGEST QUERIES TRUE OR MAGNETIC BEARING OF FLASH AND CLOUD, BEARING ANY VISIBLE LAND, WHETHER POSITION GIVEN ESTABLISHED CELESTIAL OBSERVATION OR DEAD RECKONING, SOUNDINGS IF ANY TAKEN, CURRENT VELOCITY AND SET IF KNOWN IN AREA, COURSE SAILED AND MADE GOOD FOLLOWING DETONATION, DIRECTION AND VELOCITY OF WIND AT VARIOUS TIMES.
