Attached is a copy of a letter received by this office from the Superintendent of the Electrical Department, through the General Superintendent Construction-Maintenance, for your review and action.

I fully concur with Mr. Prouty's recommendations, as set forth in his letter, which will simplify the electrical distribution systems at the old weather stations where it is now intended to use the 15 KW single phase units.

We therefore recommend that Mr. Prouty's suggestion of the purchase of additional 60 KW, 3 phase units be adopted if at all possible.

*not from the old weather stations but from the generator house. It is recommended that the 60 KW 3 phase units be installed in the generator house to determine feasibility of making the double circuit bus system.*
