RECORDS ALBUQUERQUE OPERATIONS OFFICE, AEC INDICATE THE FOLLOWING  
INFORMATION REGARDING HARBOR TUGS HULL NUMBERS AND USED  
AT ENIWETOK. TUGS WERE LIFTED TO PEARL HARBOR, INSPECTED BY AND TURNED  
OVER TO THE TRANSPORTATION OFFICER, SCHOFIELD BARRACKS HAWAII DURING MAY  
OR JUNE 1960.

PARA. PRIOR TO LOAN TO THE AEC, THE TUGS WERE UNDER CONTROL OF U.S. ARMY,  
JAPAN, CAMP ZAMA, JAPAN. AEC WAS ADVISED BY INFO COPY OF TWX FROM COMFOURTEEN  
TO CJTF-7, WASHINGTON, DC, THAT BOTH ARMY TUGS HAD BEEN LIFTED TO WESTPAC  
012015Z DECEMBER 1960. AEC REPRESENTATIVE WAS INFORMED TUGS WOULD BE RETURNED  
TO THE FAR EAST, POSSIBLY KOREA. THIS WAS APPARENTLY ACCOMPLISHED SINCE  
ALBUQUERQUE OPERATIONS OFFICE AEC HAS AN INFO COPY OF A TWX DATE TIME GROUP  
R 290510Z JUNE 1961 FROM COMMANDING GENERAL, 7TH LOGISTICAL COMMAND/TCMA/  
SEOUL, KOREA TO RUWMLD/CG USA TRANS MAT COMD, ST. LOUIS, MISSOURI, WHICH  
STATED A BREAKDOWN OF COSTS TO RESTORE VESSELS TO SERVICEABLE CONDITIONS. AEC  
HAS NO FURTHER RECORD OF SUBJECT HARBOR TUGS. MA:T:WCM.
