WHILE I WAS AT MAJURO LAST WEEK, THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY ASKED TO DISCUSS THE SUBJECT OF NON-BIKINIANS WHO HAVE LIVED AND WORKED ON BIKINI - SOME FOR SEVERAL YEARS. THESE MEN, WHO HAVE BEEN EMPLOYED BY THE DISTRICT (AS AGRICULTURISTS, FOR EXAMPLE) WILL NO LONGER HAVE EMPLOYMENT AFTER THE BIKINI EXODUS AND THUS WILL RETURN TO THEIR HOME ATOLLS. PEOPLE HAD NOT YET BEEN DESIGNED IN DETAIL BUT THAT I AM CONFIDENT IT WILL NOT MAKE A GENEALOGICAL DISTINCTION BETWEEN OP AMONG THOSE WHO HAVE BEEN RESIDENT OF BIKINI FOR SIGNIFICANT PERIODS. AND EXPECT TO BE NOTIFIED OF THE PLANS. I ANSWERED YES, AND THAT WE WOULD WORK THROUGH THE DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR TO KEEP IN TOUCH WITH THEM. HE EMPHASIZED THAT HE WOULD LIKE ANOTHER MEETING AS SOON AS OUR PLANS ARE KNOWN.
