2. AIRCRAFT & HELICOPTERS:

In a telephone discussion between Major Power and Major Miller, CO 24th Heliron Squadron, Major Miller laid out the following guide to be used in determining whether a flight was or was not special:

Special flights are; - Flights requiring altitudes above 800'.
 Flights before sunrise and after sunset.
 Flights requiring the copter to hover over the open sea.

All the flights may be authorized direct by the Elmer Dispatcher. When an officer from the copter squadron is on duty at the airport (minus one days) he will obtain approval for the flight through his operations channels. When at a time other than minus one day and/or shot day the J-3 section of TC 7.1 can go direct to 24th Heliron operations section or the 7.4 operations. (EHP)

3. PERSONNEL:

Major Santo Italia, Ensign James Williams and Yeoman Dean Robinson arrived at Elmer yesterday, 4 July. Ensign Williams departed Elmer on 5 July to accompany the FOPLAR device to BIKINI. Dean Robinson will depart tomorrow, 6 July, for JOHNSTON Island. Major Italia plans to depart for JOHNSTON Island on Tuesday 8 July. (FAP)

4. SHOTS & DEVICES:

a. The DOGWOOD barge arrived at ENIWETOK from BIKINI on Friday 4 July via LSD and was placed at the deep water pier at 0730 hours.

LCU 469 with J-3 Representative Carl Hansen, Jeep #71 and one 'H' boat departed for zero site area at 0930.
 Station '2' (DOGWOOD) departed for zero site at 1030 hours.
 Station '2' arrived Janet 1350 hours.
 Station '2' moored in final position for dry runs at 1525 hours.
 A dry run was held at 1730 hours. (EHP)

b. By TWK 032238Z, UCRL officially cancelled the contingency event code-word BUCKEYE. (EHP)

c. 5 July was officially DOGWOOD minus one as of 1700 hours. (FAP)

5. VEHICLES AND TRAILERS:

Jeeps #55 & 65, weapons carrier #333 were turned over to J-4 today for shipment to BIKINI for use of TU-3. (FAP)

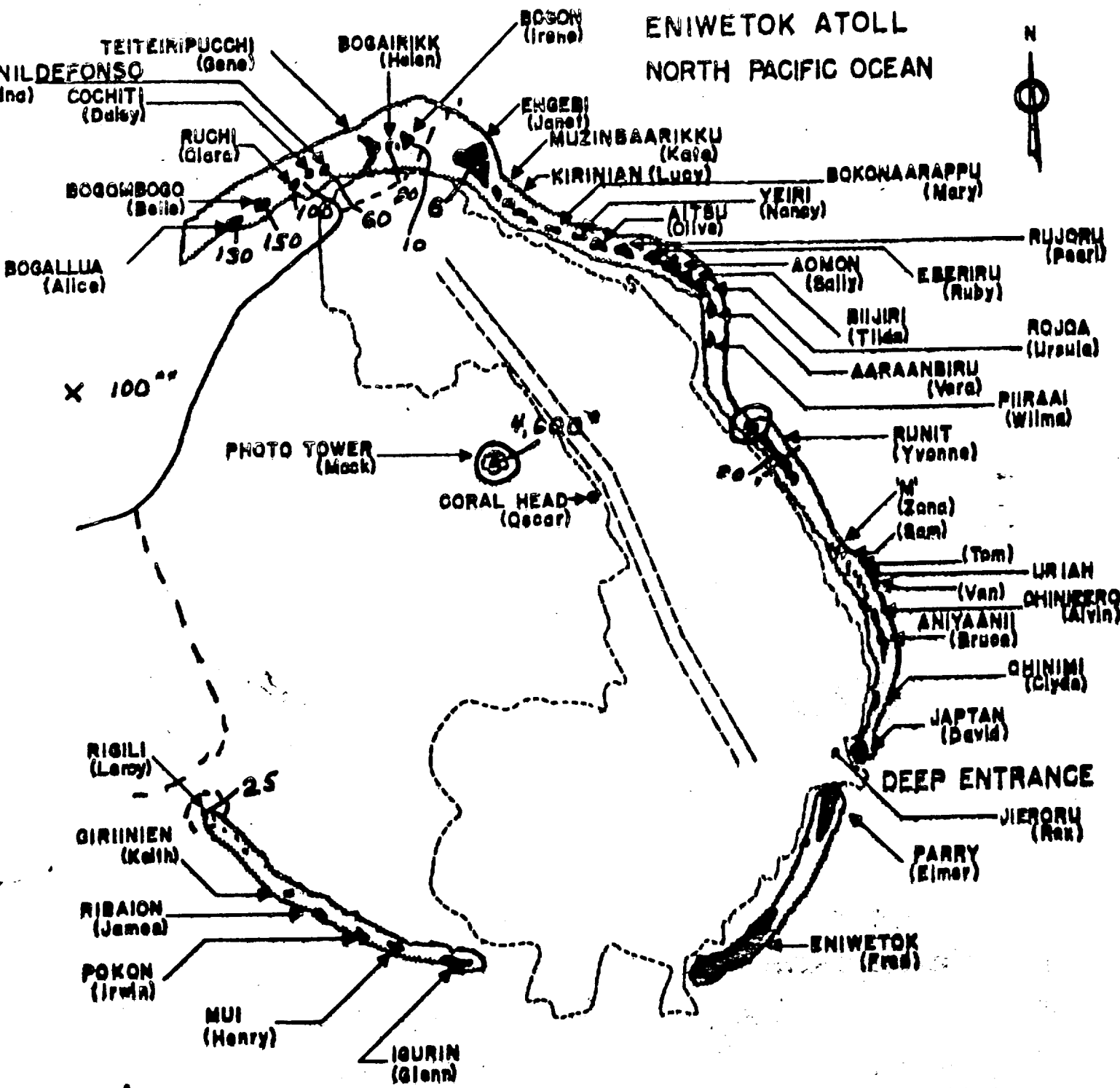
