Morning Conference on August 5, 1956, President Dwight D. Eisenhower, J. P. Dulles, Gerald R. Ford, and others at the White House.

1. The proposal of the FBI to extend the period of the extension over four years to include the 20th anniversary of the authority to use an intelligence report of the original source of information.

These points were made:

- 1. Was the Department to have a copy of the report? The report was to be handled and not over-copied.
- 2. If a copy of the report is made, will it contain the original and the copy of the original? Will it be a copy of the original or a copy of the copy?
- 3. The FBI was to appear before the Senate and report on the matter.
- 4. The President authorized the FBI to report to the Senate on the matter.

Alternative Conference on August 11, 1956, President Dwight D. Eisenhower, J. P. Dulles, Robert F. Kennedy, and others at the White House.

1. The President approved the proposal for the extension of the period in 1956 with the understanding that a copy of the report be made by the FBI and the State Department.
