1. South American Trip. Mr. Hall reported on the Technical Mission's activities and observations.
2. Asian Nuclear Center. A letter to the Secretary of State, with a copy to Mr. Hollister, is to be prepared concerning use of scientists for foreign activities. (Foster)
3. Press Announcement on Operation REDWING. Discussed. The routine announcement is to be deferred until after consideration of the Chairman's statement. We will not ask the staff to undertake any action on this matter.
4. Letter to Senator Anderson re ACRS Report. A revised letter is to be circulated on July 20 for the Commissioners' approval.

A letter to Governor Williams is to be prepared inviting his representative to review the report and explaining the functions and responsibilities of the ACRS. (Price)
