The Utirik Council and Mr. Jorout,

As you know there are three Atomic Energy Commission buildings at Utirik which have been designated for medical examinations of the Utirik people by the AEC medical team at intervals of several years. AEC is paying rental on the land these buildings occupy. The use of these buildings for school purposes would not interfere in any way with the use of the buildings for medical survey purposes provided it is understood that the buildings would be turned over to the AEC medical team for the short period necessary for the surveys. Such use of the buildings would insure that they would be kept up properly.
