We have requested Dr. Robert A. Conrad and Mr. William A. Scott, both of the Brookhaven National Laboratory, Upton, L.I., N.Y., to prepare to travel to the Marshall Islands on or about 1 March 1960. The purpose of this trip is to carry out a medical survey of the Marshallese natives exposed to fallout in March 1954, as a continuation of our responsibilities to these people.

In this connection, it would be greatly appreciated if you would undertake to make the following arrangements:

1. U. S. Naval Support Activity at Eniwetok be authorized to furnish Dr. Conrad and Mr. Scott air transportation between Eniwetok and each of the following islands: Majuro and Rongelap. Only one or two flights are expected to be necessary.
2. It is anticipated that Dr. Conrad and Mr. Scott will use MATS transportation between Fieblem Field, Eniwetok and Eniwetok. Dr. Conrad already has your letter of permit for travel on military aircraft (OP-90824/bb Ser 456-PO982) which was issued 12 November 1959 and apparently is still effective. It is requested that Mr. Scott be issued a similar authorization for travel on military aircraft.
3. MATS cargo shipment of three (3) boxes, approximately 50 cu.ft., 500 lb., from Travis AFB to Eniwetok and return. This cargo will be shipped to the JTF-7 Liaison Officer at Travis on or about 1 February 1960.
