MEDICAL SURVEILLANCE OF BIKINI WORKERS.

WHILE I WAS AT MAJURO LAST WEEK, THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY ASKED TO DISCUSS THE SUBJECT OF NON-BIKINIANS WHO HAVE LIVED AND WORKED ON BIKINI - SOME FOR SEVERAL YEARS. THESE MEN, WHO HAVE BEEN EMPLOYED BY THE DISTRICT (AS AGRICULTURISTS, FOR EXAMPLE) WILL NO LONGER HAVE EMPLOYMENT AFTER THE BIKINI EXODUS AND THUS WILL RETURN TO THEIR HOME ATOLLS. THEY ANTICIPATE THAT THERE WILL BE SOME MEDICAL FOLLOW-UPS OF THE BIKINIANS AND WONDER IF THEY WILL BE INCLUDED.

I TOLD THE D.A. THAT THE FOLLOW-UP SURVEILLANCE OF THE BIKINI

NEBA WAS THE SPOKESMAN. ALSO PRESENT WERE JIM WINN, DIST ATTY AND HARRY BROWN.

I REPEATED WHAT I HAD EARLIER SAID TO JIM WINN, I.E. WE DO NOT EXPECT ANY MEDICAL PROBLEMS AS A RESULT OF THE BIKINI EXPOSURES; THE FOLLOW-UP SURVEILLANCE OF BIKINIANS HAS NOT YET BEEN PLANNED IN DETAIL, BUT WHATEVER PROGRAM IS ADOPTED I AM SURE THAT ALL PEOPLE WHO HAVE RESIDED ON BIKINI WILL BE CONSIDERED EQUALLY.
