b. Delete the last paragraph in section 2 and substitute the following:
"In view of the BRAVO results, estimated yields for ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~
have been revised upward. As additional data becomes available it is anticipated
that new yield estimates for other weapons and devices will be forthcoming. They
will be issued to interested participants as they become available. The present
most probable yields and limits are given, but the limits are not absolute. Ex-
perimenters must instrument to accept a rather wide range yield-wise. Probable
times of LASL shots will be about one half hour before sunrise. The time of
UCRL shots will be sunrise minus thirty minutes to the nearest five minutes".

2. It is not deemed advisable at this time to correct all references to
specific shots throughout the various annexes and appendices of the Operation
Plan. In general, it is believed that these references will be self explanatory
in view of the revised schedule. In those cases where the meaning of a section
containing a shot reference appears to be confused by the new schedule, this
headquarters may be contacted for clarification.
