PART ONE

FOLLOWING LETTER FROM CHAIRMAN MC COME TO SECRETARY GATES WAS SIGNED JUNE 3, 1960.

" I REFER TO MR. DOUGLAS' LETTER OF MAY 16, 1960, IN WHICH HE AGREED THAT THERE IS NO LONGER A NEED TO RETAIN THE KNIVETOK PROVING GROUND AS A NUCLEAR TEST FACILITY, AND STATED A DOD REQUIREMENT FOR THE AREA AS AN ADDITION TO THE PACIFIC MISSILE RANGE.

"CONTACT IS ALREADY ESTABLISHED BETWEEN THE PACIFIC MISSILE RANGE AND THE ALBUQUERQUE OPERATIONS OFFICE OF THE ATOMIC ENERGY COMMISSION FOR THE PURPOSE OF PREPARING A PLAN FOR THE ORDERSLY TURNOVER OF FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT TO THE DOD. ALSO, I CONCUR IN YOUR PLAN TO HAVE THE PACIFIC MISSILE RANGE NEGOTIATE WITH HOLMES AND NARVER TO OPERATE THE FACILITY FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE.

"I HAVE INSTRUCTED THE DIRECTOR OF MILITARY APPLICATION TO UNDERTAKE WITH SUCH REPRESENTATIVE DOD AGENCY AS YOU MAY DESIGNATE, THE FORMULATION OF A WRITTEN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE AEC AND THE DOD WHICH

DEPARTMENTS OF STATE AND INTERIOR WERE INFORMED OF OUR PLANS FOR TRANSFER OF EPG BY LETTERS FROM CHAIRMAN MC CONE DATED JUNE 8, 1960. CONSIDERATION IS NOW BEING GIVEN TO AN APPROPRIATE PRESS RELEASE. ^{By OCB}

PART THREE

YOU ARE AUTHORIZED TO TAKE NECESSARY ACTIONS DESCRIBED IN REFERENCE TWX TO ACCOMPLISH TRANSFER OF EQUIPMENT AND FACILITIES AT EPG TO THE PACIFIC MISSILE RANGE BY JULY 1, 1960. DMA IS CONTINUING TO NEGOTIATE WITH DOD A BILATERAL AGREEMENT FOR THE TRANSFER OF EPG AND WILL KEEP YOU INFORMED AS TO ITS PROGRESS.

PARA IT IS REQUESTED THAT YOU TAKE NO ACTION TO TERMINATE OFF ATOLL LEASES UNTIL DOD DECIDES WHETHER DOD DESIRES TO TAKE THEM OVER. (JTF-7 IS NOW RESOLVING THAT QUESTION.)

PARA PMR DOES NOT DESIRE TO TAKE OVER THE AFDL, ALOTO, OR THE TWO ARMY TUGS. ~~FROM PRELIMINARY CONCERNS IT APPEARS THAT DOD WILL NOT WAIVE THE REQUIREMENT FOR JOINT INSPECTION, AND INDICATED REPAIRS~~

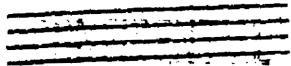
