been surrossure of a concrete by a concrete cap (photograph attacked).

The United States is about to return the atoll to the People of Enewetak, and U.S. responsibility for the Frust Territory of the Pacific is acheduled to be terminated in 1981. It is important for the U.S. to provide the People of Enewetak and the Narshallese Covernment with a competent, objective radiation safety assessment of this containment. National and international sensitivities about radiation injury and radioactive waste disposal make this a matter of great significance.

As Department of Defense (DoD) Project Manager for the Enewetak radiological cleanup operation, I request that the Mational Academy of Sciences assess the effectiveness of the Cactos crater structure in preventing harmful amounts of radioactivity from becoming available for internal of external human exposure, and recommend whether the assessment should be reviewed at intervals in the future.

I feel the National Acodemy of Sciences is the only organization capable of making an effective assessment, for two reasons:
