Communications

EG&G installed voice count down receiver with complete antenna installation on African Queen at 0900 hours this date. At 1005 hours received word that VIP trip aboard African Queen had been cancelled. Informed EG&G to remove radio equipment.

At 1120 hours word was received to re-install voice count down receiver in African Queen. Notified EG&G and commenced immediately. Radio equipment installed and checked out by 1145 hours.

Upon Barkley's suggestion contacted George Barrow (TG 7.5 Communications) in regards to use of circuit J-135 for use by Rad-Safe Personnel at Bikini Atoll. Barrow agreeable to loaning subject circuit to Rad-Safe. This "loan" will be satisfactory for our use as can be used as long as TU-7 may require.

Evacuation Re-entry & Recovery

Rad-Safe survey departed at 1356 hours and was completed at 1455 hours. Only the Janet and above photo tower recoveries were authorized since the Gene Complex was reading 600 - 900 R on the ground.
