J3-ENIWIETOK

10 May 1958

1. DOADS and SHIPS:**BEST COPY AVAILABLE**

- a. The TG 7.1 AIR will be returned to service tomorrow, Sunday. Lucke and Johnson will go to the MIKO at 0000 hours to check communications and traveling times. It is currently planned to use the AIR to evacuate the Arming Party. (ZL)
- b. Surface transportation to up-island points suited on the SUPPLIANT disarming which was delayed until 0322H. Some of the delays was due to late arrival of an LCW at Yvonne. This LCW should arrive when the Disarming Party does so it can take them out to the zero site shot barge. (JW)
- c. Other arrangements which were effective when SUPPLIANT was disarmed are as follows:
 - (1) LCW #469, assembly houseboat, departed for Yvonne.
 - (2) LCW #260 departed for Yvonne.
 - (3) LCW #454 (chow boat) departed for Gene.
 - (4) LCW #209 departed for Gene.
 - (5) Water taxi #407 departed for Yvonne, Janet, then shuttle between Gene, Irene and then depart for Ulmer at 1600 hours.

In addition, arrangements were made for a special LCW to go to Gene to evacuate trailers and vehicles since this is K-1 day. In the future, this should be coordinated with Jack Livingston (Isn't Son Sup'r Supply, HAW). Our requirements should be laid on him and he will arrange boats, tractors, caterpillars, laborers and other handling equipment. Subsequently, today was announced as K-2 day, so the LCW was re-called. (JW)

- d. A special liquid hydrogen WMAR LCW trip was set up to depart from Ulmer for Sta 33 at 1600 hours and remain until the BLIBPs were emptied. (JW)

2. MEETING:

A meeting has been set up for 1300 hours tomorrow (Sunday) to be attended by TG 7.1 agencies concerned with MIKO to discuss problems and procedures for the shot. (ZL)

5. SHOTS and DEVICES:

- a. Keith Young said he wanted HOLLY moved to Sta 3½ on BUTTERNUT plus one day but not if this coincided with KODI day. This is PINK barge. (JW)
- b. The decision was made that KODI would be considered B+1 thereby eliminating conflict as to which would be fired if both were minus 1. (JW)
- c. New shot times were established for HOLY. These are 0630, 0644, 0658. (JW)

5. WEATHER:

Received an adverse weather report which, if it develops, would ground air transportation. John Paolozzi was called and he dispatched a T-boat and DUKW to James, Henry, Keith and Glenn. Williams has plenty of surface trans- at Janet, Gene and Irene, and can pick up some people on Alice and Bell by LCI/DUKW combination if this becomes necessary. The Yvonne area has ample transportation. (JW)

6. The following are entries from the Duty Officer's Folder:

9 May 1958

1700 E-1 and B-1 from Texas OP - all notified.

2150 Texas advises this is F-1 and F-1L. All concerned notified, except Sta 71.

2210 Arming Party departs for BUTTERNUT barge by African Queen.

2220 Permission to arm both FIR and BUTTERNUT granted.

2302 Col Gattis reports arming FIR at Charlie completed 2300. DOD ALF Party at Nan 0030. T-boat from Choe DIA Nan 0040. Delayed info to Texas.

10 May 1958

0110 Texas advises this is now H-1.

0125 Arming completed on BUTTERNUT. ALF Team will leave by houseboat in 10 min. Passed info to Texas.

0250 DOD ALF Party back on Nan. All personnel secure.

0330 Texas advises both shots postponed. It is now FIR-1, KODI-1 Primary, and BUTTERNUT-1, Alternate. All advised.

0415 Disarming Party to leave Elmer by chopper at 0330. LCI leaves Elmer at 0745, stands by at Bruce until notified it is clear, then proceeds to Yvonne to pick up Disarming Party. LCI is ordered. Chopper does not have specific departure time.

6. Continued

- 0820 Safety clocks on device run out. LCM on way to Yvonne.
- 0730 JTF SEVEN gave permission for copter to go to Glenn prior to completion of disarming.
- 0922 Disarming Party completed disarming BUTTERNUT at 0922 on 10 May 1958. Marine Operations notified.
- 0950 Don Shuster came in and said this was HOA-2 and this would be announced shortly.
- 1445 Texans called - F-1, B-1 and K-2. All persons notified.
- 1635 Col Avery called and gave the new shot times for FIR - 0535, 0550 and 0605. Texas notified.


