"THE DIVISION OF BIOLOGY AND MEDICINE HAS APPROVED PLANS FOR A SPECIAL SURVEY OF THE BIKINI ATOLL DURING THE MONTHS OF APRIL AND MAY, 1967. THIS SURVEY WILL INVOLVE PARTICIPANTS FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON, THE U. S. NAVAL RADIOLOGICAL DEFENSE LABORATORY, AND THE HEALTH AND SAFETY LABORATORY. NO PROVISION FOR LOGISTICAL SUPPORT FOR THIS STUDY WAS MADE IN THE INITIAL FINANCIAL PLAN FOR THE NEVADA OPERATIONS OFFICE, AND IT IS OUR UNDERSTANDING THAT FUNDS CURRENTLY AVAILABLE ARE REQUIRED FOR THE SUPPORT OF RESEARCH PROGRAMS AT THE UNIVETCK MARINE BIOLOGY LABORATORY AND THE MEDICAL SURVEY UNDER DR. ROBERT CONARD
