SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT

FOLDER UNKNOWN

THIS SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT, entered into this 21st day of March, 1946, by and between the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA (hereinafter called the "Government"), represented by the Contracting Officer executing this agreement, and UNION MINES DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION (hereinafter called the "Contractor"),

WITNESSETH THAT:

WHEREAS, on the 17th day of April, 1944, and on the 11th day of May, 1945, the parties hereto entered into Contract No. W-7405-eng-78, for the purpose of...

WHEREAS, this contract has been previously modified by Modification No. 1; and

WHEREAS, it is found advantageous and in the best interest of the Government to modify said contract as hereinafter provided; and

WHEREAS, this modification is authorized by the First War Power Act, 1941, and Executive Order No. 9001.

NOW, THEREFORE, the said contract, as previously modified, is hereby further modified in the following particulars, but in no other respect:

1. Add the following Section to Article I-A - Objectives and Scope:

"7. The Contractor agrees to furnish such of its personnel as shall be mutually agreed upon between the parties hereto for the purpose of having said personnel render such services in connection with the 'Copperheads Project' as shall be required by the Contracting Officer"

2. Add the following Paragraph to Section 1 of Article I-A - Reimbursement For Contractor's Costs Incurred:

"4. If any of the personnel furnished by the Contractor in accordance with Section 7 of Article I-A shall be required to travel, the Government will reimburse the Contractor for the transportation of such personnel including mileage, travel expenses, and will allow for such travel Six Dollars (\$6.00) per day in lieu of all other expenses, such transportation by automobile for such travel shall be reimbursed at the rate of Five Cents (\$.05) per mile as reported on the actual mileage statement. However, in no event, that if any of such personnel shall be required to travel outside

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the continental United States, the Contractor will provide such personnel with travel allowances and in addition there shall be provided for each person traveling seven dollars (\$7.00) per day for all expenses. All travel shall be authorized in writing by the Contracting Officer.

3. Add the following Section to Article IV-B:

"ARTICLE IV-B. INSURANCE. The Contractor shall cure and maintain the Contractor's employees and for such periods as may be required by the Contracting Officer or approve, for the purpose of providing hazard coverage to such personnel as the Contractor furnish in accordance with Section 7 of Article I of this contract."

4. Add the following Section to Article IV-B, Definition:

"'Biosroads Project' as used herein shall be deemed to include all activities of the Joint Chiefs of Staff of the Army and Navy Departments relative to the tests of the Atomic Bomb against Naval vessels in the Marshall Islands during the year 1952."
