The detonation of the first nuclear device in a new series of tests by the AEC and the DOD took place Saturday 5 May, 1956, Eniwetok time. The detonation was produced by a reltv. small device with a yield only in the kiloton range. The device was detonated on the surface of Runit Is, Eniwetok Atoll, Eniwetok Proving Gnd. The detonation was viewed by 15 U.S. news correspondants and by 17 representatives of civ. def.
