Dear Mr. Norwood:

This letter serves to review preparations for the fort, oming special medical examinations of the Rongelap people scheduled to begin the latter part of February. Though we have not received final word on Trust Territory transportation support, it is necessary that we proceed with final arrangements from this end. Unless we hear to the contrary, we are therefore assuming that:

- (a) A ship will transport or advance medical team and equipment from Kwajalein to Rongolap on February 23 (Trust Territory time).
- (b) A ship will be available to transport medical equipment and possibly certain personnel on March 15 (TT time) from Rongelap to Kwajalein. Either (a) or (b) would be in conjunction with a routine TT and Marshall Island field trip operation and the other trip would probably have to be chartered on AEC expenses.
- (c) On March 1 (TT time) an SA-16 flight to transport members of the medical team from Kwajalein to Rongelap along with personal luggage will be arranged, and
- (d) On March (5 (TT time) an SA-16 flight to transport medical team personnel from Rongelap to Kwajalein. These flights would be chartered by AEC-Honolulu, and they may already have or will negotiate the above transportation with Mr. Windel at Saipan and Dwight Heine at Majuro.

Please note that the days for the SA-16 flights are at a time when these planes normally are at Kwajalein, and discussions with one of the Pan American pilots last September indicated that such a mission could be carried out without interrupting the routine SA-16 schedule. Department of Interior sent me the UN Visiting Mission schedule, and though it appears that one week SA-16's will be used at times for transportation for this group, the dates of our requests do not appear to conflict. I hope this is the case.

We have added one person to our team, and the list of participants from the United States is as follows:

If the above schedule holds, we would appreciate having Mr. Libby and Mr. Shoniber or Mr. Mizutoni at Kwajalein by February 22 (TT time) to assist in preliminary arrangements. The remainder of the TT personnel should be at Kwajalein in time to leave at 0800 1 March (TT time) by plane for the trip from Kwajalein to Rongelap.

The anticipated schedule, using only TT time, is as follows:

February 21-22 - Advance team arrives Kwajalein.

February 23 - Trust Territory ship transports advance team and equipment from Kwajalein to Rongelap.

March - SA-16 transports remainder of medical team from Kwajalein to Rongelap.

March 1-15 - Rongelap examinations.

March 15 - TT ship transports medical team from Rongelap to Kwajalein (plane needed in order to allow time for special examinations at Ebeye by thyroid expert who must return early to the U.S.)

March 15-21 - Ebeye examinations.

March 22 - TT plane (routine) Kwajalein to Majuro for 13 members of
 medical team.

March 24 - Army DC-4 from Kwajalein to transport medical team from Majuro to Kwajalein.
