THE AEC WILL REQUIRE THE USE OF LCU-26 FROM NOVEMBER 24 THRU

DECEMBER 14 FOR AN AEC SCIENTIFIC AND MEDICAL MISSION BY PERSONNEL OF
BROOKHAVEN NATIONAL LABORATORY, UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON AND UNIVER-
SITY OF HAWAII. THE PRESENT PLANS CALL FOR THE LCU TO DEPART KWAJALEIN,
PROCEED TO UTIKIK TO RONGERIK TO RONGELAP TO BIKINI TO AILINGINAE AND
RETURN TO KWAJALEIN. THE LCU SHOULD HAVE THE FOLLOWING EQUIPMENT ON
BOARD:

1. THE NEW AEC 25 KW GENERATOR (THIS GENERATOR IS SCHEDULED TO
ARRIVE KWAJALEIN NOT LATER THAN OCTOBER 22 AND SHOULD BE
INSTALLED ON THE LCU IN THE LOCATION AS DISCUSSED BY KEN WEBB

3. AEC DISPENSARY TRAILER (WITH X-RAY UNIT INSTALLED IN TRAILER).
4. AEC BOSTON WHALER NO. 2.
5. AEC JEEP.

PART 2

IT IS PLANNED THAT DR. R. CONRAD, N. GREENHOUSE AND W. MEINHOLD OF
BNL, AND STREEMAN OF AEC WILL PROCEED VIA MAC TO ENEWETAK FROM
HONOLULU ON DECEMBER 4. IT IS REQUESTED THAT THE ARMY C-54 BE MADE
AVAILABLE UNDER A CHARTER BASIS TO THE AEC AND FLY TO ENEWETAK ON
DECEMBER 8 AND PICK UP THESE FOUR ABOVE LISTED PEOPLE AND FOUR
PERSONNEL FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII, AND PROCEED TO BIKINI WHERE
GREENHOUSE, MEINHOLD AND THE FOUR UNIVERISYT OF HAWAII PERSONNEL WILL
DEPLANE AND JOIN THE LCU GROUP. DR. KNUDSEN, THE X-RAY TECHNICIAN,
AND FIVE MARSHALLESE MEDICAL PATIENTS WILL JOIN STREEMAN AND CONRAD
AND RETURN ON THE C-54 TO KWAJALEIN THE SAME DAY.
