Subject: Salary, Wage, Travel, and Expense Rules for Pacific Proving Ground -
 Effective April 1964.

Dear Mr. Goodbrand:

Attached are copies of the subject rules for your review and approval. These rules will supersede the currently approved Salary, Wage, Travel, and Expense Rules for the Pacific Proving Grounds and the revisions submitted to you by R. E. Conwell in his letter of April 7, 1964.

In preparing these revisions, we have made those changes which align to the current operational plan. The zone dislocation (differential) allowance provisions which applied to Honolulu and Hawaii are revised for this operation to apply to duty posts outside the State of Hawaii, French Frigate Shoals, and aboard airborne operational aircraft.

The provisions for advisory assignments remain unchanged - normal 40 hour work week pay and no differential allowance.

We are following our current policy of stipulating tourist or economy class commercial air as the normal mode of transportation between the Mainland and Hawaii.

As to living expenses in Hawaii, we would prefer to pay for actual cost of reasonable lodging consistent with our regular travel policy. The \$15.00 daily subsistence allowance is also included and if elected at any time by the traveler, will apply for the balance of his tour of duty in Hawaii.

A per diem of \$5.40 will be reimbursed to employees at locations (including State of Hawaii) where eating facilities are furnished by a civilian support contractor. This is consistent with the AEC and other AEC contractors' policy, which allow \$2.40 to the individual for incidentals and \$3.00 for his meals.

Your early action on this matter will be appreciated.
