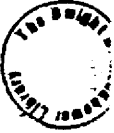

ON AEC PUBLIC INFORMATION AND EDUCATION PLAN
FOR OPERATION PLUMBBOB (1957 Nevada Test Series)
dtd March 22, 1957

It was further noted that if foreign media observers were invited to and attended one or more of the shots in the series USIA and State would provide combined written guidance to help AEC and DOD assure that the briefings held for and subject matter kits issued to all correspondents would be of maximum service to foreign as well as domestic correspondents. AEC noted also that holding separate briefings and issuing separate kits for U. S. and for foreign correspondents would create many difficulties in media relationships and should be avoided.
