Dear Allen:

This is to inform you of the present status of my plans for attending the forthcoming series of nuclear tests at the Pacific Proving Ground.

As I indicated to you previously, I plan to make the trip in the last two weeks of June. It now appears that I will depart Washington on about June 15 so as to arrive in the forward area at a time to permit witnessing the detonation of one of our megaton test devices. In general, the trip will follow a schedule of three days spent en route Eniwetok, with overnight stops at Travis Air Force Base in California and Hickam Air Force Base in Hawaii, a stay of four days in the Pacific Proving Ground area, and a period of four days spent on the return trip. All told, the time away from Washington will be about eleven or twelve days.

My staff is making necessary arrangements for the trip, and I will provide you with further information as it becomes available.

I am happy that your present plans will permit you to make the trip with me.
