Dear Mrs. Van Cleve;

Thank you for your letter of June 26, 1979 concerning the meeting we had in Washington June 13,1979.

It appears to me that the notes you enclosed accurately describe the points discussed at the meeting. However, there is one minor correction and that is Mr. Tarlekehol went as Henchi Balos's staff member rather than a "Bikini/Kili Council Member".

Also, pertaining to part 10 an page 5, the point that Mr. Wiesgall made is that those people tested on Bikini by the Whole Body Counter may have been contaminated on Ronglap rather than Bikini. I am referring to internal contamination from local foods grwn on Ronglap. Eneu, Bikini and the southern islands of Ronglap are identical in radiation backgroun levels (G) according to the latest"RADIOLOGICAL SURVEY OF THE NORTHERN MARSHALLS". Of the 156 people removed from Bikini 25 had been living on Ronglap before they migrated to Bikini in 1975. This was about the time a sudden jump was noted in the Whole Body Counter tests at Bikini which was attributed to coconut trees becoming productive. I'm concerned that it may have been caused by the 25 people from Ronglap who had been ingesting radionuclides since 1957 when they were returned to Ronglap. Their systems had the opportunity to accumulate radionuclides for 18 years prior to their migration to Bikini.

This brings up another question. Since Ronglap has more or the same level of Gama Rays being emitted as on Eneu (indicated by the 1978 RADIOLOGICAL SURVEY), why were the Ronglapese returned to their island 22 years ago and the Bikinians not allowed to return to Eneu for another 25 years? Both Eneu and Ronglap were contaminated by the same tests and have identical radiation levels. Is there a double standard used here?

You will find enceised a portion of the statistics I've compiled of the people removed from Bikini in the Fall of 1979. I hope this information clarifies part 10 and the latest Bikini relocation. Most official report I've seen, indicate that almost all removed from Bikini were Bikinian. This is certainly not the case. The Bikini/Kili Council released a directive in 1972 telling all Bikinians not to return to Bikini until they authorized them to do so as there were certain questions and request made to the T.T. that were unresolved. The Bikini/Kili Council was opposed to anyone living on Bikini without their approval. That may explainly so many people lining on Bikini were non-Bikinian and why all most alremoved did not go to Kili to live.

It certainly was a pleasure seeing you again and an honer for me to attemthe meeting held in your office June 13, 1979. All correspondence directed to Tomaki through me has been passed on to him.
