Mr. Salisbury reported that an Atoms-for Peace exhibit would be on display in the Munitions Building in Washington during the week of June 11, 1956. He said that this display was one of three which would be shown throughout the U. S. Mr. Strauss said he believed that the number of such exhibits should, in the future, be increased. Mr. Thompson said that an expansion of this program was being planned.
