Dear Mr. Secretary:

Attached is a copy of a letter I recently wrote to the President and which Mr. Loper reviewed prior to its transmittal. On the afternoon of 9 August the President discussed with me the subject of this letter. The Secretary of State was present. In the discussion the President made the following points:

a. He approved our proceeding now with preparations for Operation HARDTACK with a starting date of 1 April 1958. He expressed an interest in starting earlier, but I informed him that April appeared the earliest that a balanced series could be started.

b. He expressed considerable doubt as to the necessity for the number of shots, approximately 25, my letter indicated as probably necessary. He directed that the planned firings be screened to hold to the smallest number practical without losing essential defense objectives. The Commission will screen those shots for weapons developments to see that this direction is met. It is requested that the Department of Defense take appropriate action relative to the military effects shots planned.

c. He directed that, for the early future, there be no public announcement of our preparations, plans or intent to hold a spring 1958 series. He directed that the preparations be conducted on a classified basis and that, prior to public announcement, he be informed so that he might review the timing and content of the announcement. The Commission will issue necessary instructions to its agencies. It is requested that the Department of Defense take such action as is necessary in this regard.
