MEMORANDUM FOR CHAIRMAN ATOMIC ENERGY COMMISSION

Dear Lewis:

This is in reply to your memorandum of September 9th answering my memorandum of August 30th concerning weapon testing.

With regard to continental tests, I am pleased to know that the President has approved T-ARTF as requested by your letter to him of August 30th.

As to my reference to General Fields' remarks at the joint AEC-NASA meeting on July 23rd concerning Pacific tests, the minutes of that meeting contain the following statement:

"General Fields commented that current plans do not include any overseas operations in which AEC will be primarily engaged until 1956".

I continue to question whether this decision, of which I was unaware and in which I did not participate, is consistent with optimum progress in weapons development.

Regarding your statement that "we should accelerate our weapons testing program when there is anything new to be learned, theory to be tested, or design to be proved"; I should like to discuss at Executive Session the advisability of circulating such a statement to Los Alamos, Livermore and other activities involved in testing. I believe that something of this nature is required in order to add impetus to our test operations and so contribute to advancing our weapons development program.
