FOR YOUR INFORMATION AN. SALISBURY'S, THE SERVICES CARRYING STORIES FROM TOKYO REPORTING TWO JAPANESE FISHING VESSELS OUTSIDE DANGER AREA ARRIVED IN PORT WITH RADIOACTIVE TUNA AND SOME OF CATCH WAS DESTROYED AS CONTAMINATED. NO ILLNESS REPORTED AMONG CREWS. VESSELS REPORTEDLY SHOWED RADIOACTIVITY. THIS INFORMATION UNCONFIRMED BY ANY OFFICIAL SOURCES. STATE DEPARTMENT HAS RECEIVED NO OFFICIAL JAPANESE REACTION. FROM INFO IN PRESS ^{MDD} ~~IT~~ ^{AP} ~~AP~~ CONTAMINATION APPEARS TO HAVE BEEN VERY SLIGHT. END REF MAT:NDG BEST COPY AVAILABLE
