1. Japanese physicians have begun release their press ver-  
sions of medical findings from autopsy. All  
Japanese doctors quoted in newspapers have agreed that  
"radiation disease" was cause of death.

2. Mister Masao Tsuzuki has publicly concurred and supplied  
following details for YOMIURI reporter: "What I was most sur-  
prised to see was that his liver, heart, kidney, spleen, pan-  
creas, and all the other internal organs affecting life had  
been so greatly changed that I could hardly recognize them.  
I think it means that radiation infiltrated and destroyed  
his body completely. I realize keenly how horrible the death  
ash is."
