REPORT BY VAL PLT BARN, CHIEF OF CIVIL DEFENSE ADMINISTRATION, BUREAU

MEETING OF STATE CIVIL DEFENSE COMMISSION, CHICAGO, ILLINOIS, SEPTEMBER 28:

We have a two-fold purpose in holding these sessions. One is to enable you to lay your problems on the table, and through a free exchange of ideas, for all of us to see if we can develop some ideas that can be done about them and that lead to the desired result and to the help.

The other purpose is to give you the opportunity to present to you certain data we have concerning the civil defense program of the Government -- information which you should have for purposes to plan intelligently at the local level.

So I know you will appreciate that we are not going to be as frank as we should like to be in our reports. We will talk of the effects of atomic weapons, its striking and its potentialities. Military security and intelligence and international relations are considerations which must be weighed along with those of civil defense.

Nevertheless, I want to say to you that to find out what is going on during these three days, there will be a need for the results of certain problems which we have to submit to you. I know that nobody knows the answer yet and that we are not in a position to give reasons. Yet I am going to insist that you will leave here with all the information you need to enable you to completely work out your defense planning at this stage.
