1. NOTES AND STATE: **BEST COPY AVAILABLE**

- a. After NOLAN detonation "D" hour was unofficially announced at 0945 to the Marine Dispatcher after calling Major Jack's. All up island marine trips were approved except to Yvonne. (JW)
- b. Major Jacks said it would not be possible to lay HAWKELA moorings today; the land area is much too hot for the surveyors. (JW)
- c. LCU 450 with 1-7 trailer and "U" boat were dispatched to HAWKELA, station #20 off Junct. (JW)
- d. The UZBELLIA zero site "U" boat was loaded in an LCU bulk today as an added convenience to assembly and arming and firing personnel. (JW)

2. RECENT EVENTS:

a. HAWKELA Day Operations:

NOLAN detonated at 0630 off Yvonne (charge).

Rad-Safe survey off the ground at 0630.

"U" boat surfaced at 0700 by 2011 hours.

Project 15.1 took off at approximately 0830 from Wilma and Yvonne and successfully recovered 2011.

1st Copter was ready to go with cloud sampler at 1000 hours. (Waiting for PW-11)

Project 13.1 took off at approximately 1000 and successfully recovered 2011 from Yvonne Alpha Station.

At 1100 PW's and assembly personnel moved to HAWKELA Range and normal up-island air schedules were resumed.

At approximately 1200 hours the 2nd Rad-Safe survey took off for an aerial sweep.

At approximately 1230 hours a recovery of the Pinex "pig" was made by copter and delivered to PW at approximately 1300 hours. The cloud samples and Pinex "pig" comprise material for flying one which departed approximately 1100.

At 1300 Proj. 50.1 took aerial photography of Yvonne and returned to Wilmer. (PW)
