Mr. Brown also reported that the first teletherapy unit in the United States to employ cesium as the source of radioactivity had been demonstrated. Upon completion of a facility for recovery of cesium and other elements from the waste products of plutonium separation, radiocesium would become competitive with radioactive cobalt in price.
