HE COULD AND WOULD, I WOULD ATTEMPT TO GET AN IMMEDIATE VISIT APPROVED (NOT WANTING TO ACT UNILATE-RALLY). UNFORTUNATELY, THE SAME SUBJECT HAD BEEN AT ISSUE IN THE COURTS IN HAWAII, WITH DOD SEEKING A PRO-TECTIVE INJUNCTION. THE TERMS OF THE COURT RESOLUTION OF THAT ISSUE MADE OUR VISIT INADVISABLE, AND THE MATTER WAS DROPPED.

WE DID, HOWEVER, DECIDE THAT A VISIT TO UJELANG WOULD BE CONSTRUCTIVE. THAT SEEMED POSSIBLE SINCE A NAVY AMPHIBIAN FROM GUAM WAS ARRIVING KWAJ AND WAS PLACED AT OUR DISPOSAL. THE TRIP, WHICH WE PLANNED FOR MON-DAY 20TH, THEN ADVANCED TO SUNDAY, WAS E FINALLY CAN-CELLED DUE FIRST OF ALL TO LIMITED PASSENGER CAPACITY (4) AND SECONDLY TO CONFLICT WITH RONGELAP FUNERAL ARRANGEMENTS.

WE HAD A CONSTRUCTIVE FRIDAY MEETING WITH BARRY AND BALOS, DEBRUM AND PETE COLEMAN TO HEAR LCDR. BROWN AND EARL GILMORE DESCRIBE THEIR ACTIVITIES AND DIS-ASSOCIATE THEMSELVES FROM PACE. AGAIN I THINK BARRY

WAS COMPLETELY SATISFIED. THOUGH HE PRESSED PRETTY HARD ON A DATE FOR REPOPULATION AND FOR AN AGREE-MENT THAT IT WOULD BE ALL RIGHT TO REINHABIT JAPTAN IN ADVANCE OF THE ALL CLEAR, WE OF COURSE MADE NO COMMITMENTS ALTHOUGH I DID VENTURE A PERSONAL OPINION THAT FROM A RADIOLOGICAL STANDPOINT. ONCE THE FOOD CHAIN QUESTIONS ARE ANSWERED IT WOULD SEEM FEASIBLE TO BRING SOME PEOPLE TO JAPTAN. I DID. HOWEVER. OB-SERVE THAT THE QUESTION OF WHETHER PARTIAL REPOPULA-TION CONCURRENT WITH CLEANUP WOULD BE MANAGEABLE AND DESIRABLE IS PROPERLY A HICOM QUESTION.
