

It also helped us recognize the importance of emphasizing communication approaches that are consistent with the Marshallese culture. Because of this and geographical considerations such as the great distance from the mainland and the distances between atolls, we ~~believed~~ ^{concluded} that the success of a radiation information program in the Marshall Islands would be enhanced by utilizing existing education and information systems in the Marshall Islands.
