I believe I may have been exposed to radiation. At any rate, I now have metastatic breast cancer and multiple bone areas affected and am receiving medical treatment at the Cancer Center at the LAC/USC Medical Center-1200 North State Street, Los Angeles, Ca., telephone 226-4023.

I understand that the Atomic Energy Commission is interested in a follow-up study on those of us who took part in the testing of the bomb and I would, therefore, wish my name to be included in those being followed.
