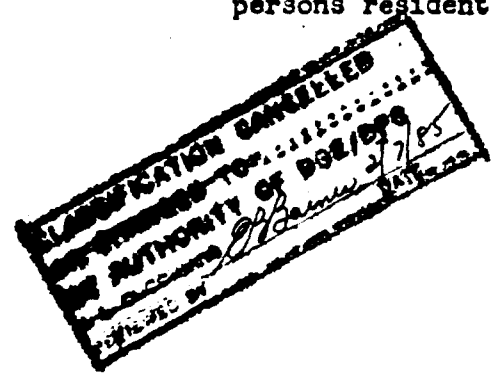
Dear General Clarkson:

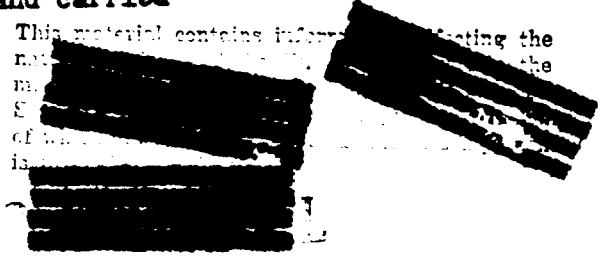
