CJTJF-7, ENIWETOK, MARSHALL ISLANDS

TO CLARKSON FROM FIELDS

IN ORDER TO BRIEF THE COMMISSION AND TO RESOLVE THE PROBLEM OF A RELEASE ON THE EVACUATION OF THE NATIVES, IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT WE RECEIVE BY QUICKEST MEANS YOUR ANALYSIS OF THE SITUATION, THE NUMBERS OF NATIVES SHOWING ILL EFFECTS AND A STATEMENT OF DEGREE, AND ANY POSSIBLE PROGNOSIS THAT YOU MAY BE ABLE TO FURNISH. YOUR REQUEST FOR SUCH RELEASE IS THOROUGHLY UNDERSTOOD, HOWEVER, THE IMPACT OF SUCH A RELEASE MUST BE CAREFULLY WEIGHED BY HIGHEST AUTHORITIES BEFORE DECISION CAN BE REACHED
