Appendices B, C and D covered costs for developing, providing and firing rockets at Hardtack. Results of experimental firings indicated that LOKI rockets would not be satisfactory as second stage units. Accordingly, arrangements have been made with JPL to obtain two RTV rocket motors for test purposes. Within the next one to three weeks, a test firing will occur, and it will be known whether or not RTV units are successful as a second stage. It appears at the moment that if they are unsuccessful, we will have to stop the program.
