
Subject: Training Program of Radiation Safety Group.

- 1. Inclosed is a copy of the training program for the radiation safety group under the direction of Col. Warren. This is the overall schedule for this group from 15 January 1946 to and including 1 April 1946.
- 2. Also inclosed is a roster of the officer members of this group with serial number and branch of service designated. All but one of these officers are members of the respective medical corps of their individual branches. Maj. William Stone is the Chemical Marfare Service representative.
- 3. In response to your request for information on material already given to these men, the following phases have been covered:
- a. Basic information on the Lanhattan District Project as typified by the Smythe Report.
- b. "Basic Nuclear Physics" as given in Pollard & Davidson textbook.
- c. Individual visits and instruction in the plant areas of the barrier separation process, the electro-magnetic separation process and the pilot plant of the "pile" process.
- 4. Slides were shown and there was discussion of the bomb effects both on humans and building structures in New Lexico, Nagasaki and Hiroshima.
- 5. It is anticipated in your work with the group at Los Alamos that further instruction in nuclear physics and practical field work
