For the two mooring buoys we recommend buoys No. 06-8-819-115 of such size and equipped with such gear as the Mavy desires for use with their tankers. The buoys will be anchored in approximately 76' of water.

Two small buoys for holding the recovery line for each submarine pipeline will also be required.
