Subject: P.C.L. PROJECT - SPT 1000

Dear Sir:

In view of the decision to install a P. .L. farm serviced by two 500' 4" submarine lines at Site Tare, it is requested that arrangements be made through the JTF-7 to have the Navy furnish and install the necessary mooring buoys during the last two weeks of August, 1953.

For the two mooring buoys we recommend buoys No. 06-E-819-115 of such size and equipped with such gear as the Navy desires for use with their tankers. The buoys will be anchored in approximately 70' of water.

Two small buoys for holding the recovery line for each submarine pipeline will also be required.
