SUBJECT: STATUS OF EPG

In Chairman McCone's April 22, 1960, letter to the Secretary of Defence, and in Mr. Douglas' reply of May 16, agreement was reached that a readiness state for nuclear test resumption at the Enivetor Proving Ground need no longer be maintained, because of the low probability that atmospheric testing will occur in the future.

In response to Chairman AcCone's inquiry as to the DoD interest in taking over EPO, Mr. Douglas replied that the DoD has a requirement for the area as an addition to the Pacific Missile Pange, and desires to make extrangement for an early transfer of the facility and equipment to that agency.

I intend, therefore, to proceed with negotiation of a satisfactory written agreement to transfer the plant facilities and the equipment and supply at the EFG on a non-reinbursable basis from the ASC to the DoD. I would intend to include in the agreement recognition in principle that the AEC could use the EFG for any activity which it might later need to conduct there if it is accomplished without cost to the DoD and without interference with DoD essential activities there.
