Replying to your letter ETP:EW-1397 of December 14, 1955, on the subject of Off-Atoll Support, and supplementing our letter No. 412 of December 23, 1955. there are submitted original cost estimates covering all known work requirements of the nature of Job I construction, which estimates are summarized as follows:

It is desired to point out the temporary camp facilities to provide messing, housing, storage, and utilities have been estimated and are considered necessary to support personnel at three sites, namely Ujelang, Utirik, and Wotho; and it is considered that the existing weather station camp facilities at Rongerik and Kusaie are sufficient to accommodate operation personnel located at these sites in connection with the scientific program. The estimates submitted herewith comprise only Job I, construction, and specifically do not include support services for scientific personnel; operation expense, Job II, involving camp operation; or maintenance empanse, Job III, which costs are carried in our accounts on an overall basis for the whole operation at Pacific Proving Ground.

Our suggested method for accounting for these indirect costs of operations proposes that food costs be assessed at the rate of \$1.50 per day per man for a standard Jobsite manu. Costs above this amount, as well as the cost of water and fuel, would be absorbed as a part of the overall operating expense of the operation.
