
Dear Mr. Harley:

In accordance with your request of September 21, we have gathered samples of sea water and live coral from the following islands and atolls: Kwajalein, Jaluit, Kili, Kusaie, Ujelang, and Wotho.

Today we turned the above samples over to Mr. C. W. Kelley, Resident Project Manager at Eniwetok. He is transporting them to Eniwetok for shipment to you by U.S. Air Force facilities, and you should receive them in the near future. Each container is labeled with the location and date of sampling. A reference to hydrographic charts will give you exact latitude and longitude.

During December and January we plan to make a complete circuit of all the atolls, and we should be able to complete a fairly wide coverage of the Marshalls area. However, our present supply of 5-gallon and 1-gallon tins will not be adequate for this complete project. We suggest you send us another shipment of three dozen each of both types of containers.
