MEMORANDUM FOR MR. ROBERT C. SPRADUE

With reference to your appearances in Washington, the following arrangements have been worked out in supplement to those arrangements stated in the March 10, 1954, memorandum:

1. You appear before the full Senate Armed Services Committee in Executive Session on Thursday, March 25 (as heretofore arranged).
2. You appear before the "Select Committee" of the Joint Committee on Atomic Energy, with representation as agreed from the House Armed Services Committee, in Executive Session, on Monday, March 29. The details of this appearance are set forth in the March 10, 1954, memorandum. The presentation will be made in Room F89 in the Capitol, which is a thoroughly secure room. Congressman Cole suggests that the presentation begin at 9:30 a.m. For answers to any further questions which you may have, I suggest that you get in touch with Mr. Wayne Brebeck, of the Joint Committee Staff, who is handling the details for Chairman Cole. His telephone number is National 8-3120, Branch 1533 or 1550.
3. It is tentatively arranged that Senator Maltonstall, you and I will see the President at 10:15 a.m. on Tuesday, March 30, for the purpose indicated in paragraph one of the March 10, 1954, memorandum.
