FILMS FOR CIVIL DEFENSE USE

SYMBOL: S.C. 100

in response to your request of yesterday, a listing below the films pertinent to civil defense against atomic weapons of which we are aware. Many of them have been used in the civil defense instructor training courses for physicians and radiological monitors jointly sponsored by the USRB and AEC. Most are available through the Division of Public and Technical Information.

a. General

1. "General Effects of the Atomic Bomb"; Air Force Training; Film TF-1-4610. This film is based on footage originally shot by USRB at Hiroshima and Nagasaki. It is in full color and runs for approximately 30 minutes. Available through the Department of Air Force.
2. "Tale of Two Cities"; an Army film showing destructive results of atomic bombing of Hiroshima and Nagasaki.
3. "Operations Crossroads"; an official Navy film in full color of Bikini preparations and two test explosions.
4. "Atom Bombs (Hiroshima. One Year After)" - Paramount News
5. "Atomic Energy"; Encyclopaedia Britannica, 10 minute film giving introduction to atomic principles.
6. "Atomic Power" - March of Time; Fundamentals of nuclear physics and events leading to wartime U. S. program. Includes re-enactments by scientists themselves of important meetings and experiments.
7. Paramount Newsreel No. 99 - Atomic Scientists of Chicago, Inc.; special collection of newsreel material assembled in three parts - Use of bombs and their effects at Hiroshima and Nagasaki; Bikini scenes; and section dealing with international control.
8. "Atomic Physics"; J. Arthur Rank Ltd. An authoritative, five-part film on history and development of nuclear physics.
