Dear Mr. Secretary:

Yesterday I consulted further with Governor Sherman Adams and with Secretary Dulles on the proposal to carry a group of foreign official observers to Operation REDWING. It was agreed that the proposal would not be effectuated and that the use of a second vessel, therefore, would not be required. This does not affect the use of the USS NY, MCKINLEY which is to accommodate other observers.
